NOTE TO STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL CONDITION
MARCH 31, 2010

NOTE 1 - The Statement of Financial Condition of Alpine Securities Corporation ("Company") is prepared by management of the Company and is not audited. Certain information and footnote disclosures normally included in financial statements prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America have been condensed or omitted. The Statement of Financial Condition should be read in conjunction with the September 30, 2009 audited Statement of Financial Condition and the notes thereto. The unaudited Statement of Financial Condition reflects all adjustments, consisting only of normal recurring adjustments that, in the opinion of management of the Company, are necessary to present fairly the financial position of the Company at March 31, 2010.

NOTE 2 – NET CAPITAL REQUIREMENTS

The Company is subject to the Securities and Exchange Commission Uniform Net Capital Rule (rule 15c3-1), which requires the maintenance of minimum net capital and requires that the ratio of aggregate indebtedness to net capital, both as defined, shall not exceed 15 to 1; and prohibits a broker-dealer from engaging in securities transactions when its net capital falls below minimum requirements as defined by the rule. At March 31, 2010, the Company had net capital of 1,743,647 which was \$1,493,647 in excess of its required net capital of \$250,000. The Company's net capital ratio was .38 to 1.
